- Sale/Swap Meet will be on the grounds of the Deacon Andrew Hetfield House, Constitution Plaza, Mountainside
- The sale/swap hours are 9:00am-2:00pm on Saturday, April 29, 2017. Swap Meet participants should arrive between 7:30 and 8:30am for set-up.
- We estimate 150-250 visitors during the sale/swap.
- Sale and swap Meet participants should provide their own tables.  
(A limited number of 5-6ft. oblong lightweight tables are available and would cost an additional \$10 each.)
- The Mountainside Restoration Committee will provide advertising and publicity to promote attendance.
- Examples of Swap Meet participation includes:** New or used household items, toys, games, equipment, tools, sports items, clothing, etc. resulting from your Spring Cleaning. New giftware, cosmetics, jewelry, crafts, artwork, etc. You are responsible for staffing your table and for swapping or selling your own items. You or your group keeps profits from the swapping or sale of your items.  
Individuals, families or community groups are welcome to participate.
- In the event of rain, the Sale and Swap Meet will be held in Mountainside Fire Department's garage next door.
- Participants are responsible for the clean-up and removal of all items from your own Swap Meet space.
